

## POLITICAL SCIENCE GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

### I. 13 Total Political Science Classes

Comprised of Subfield requirements (4 courses) and PS Electives (9 courses)

### II. Subfield requirements:

Students must complete one course out of each of the following subfield areas:

- 1) American Politics or Law & Politics
- 2) Comparative Politics-
- 3) Political Theory
- 4) International Relations

### III. Social Science Requirement

Any 2 courses from the following departments: Anthropology, Economics, Geography, Psychology, Sociology

### IV. History Requirement

Any 2 courses from the following departments: History, History of Art, History of Science and Technology

All courses must be taken for a grade aside from the covered classes freshman year. Grades received for all classes must be a C or above. All courses used to fulfill the Subfield requirements must be taken at JHU or a JHU-affiliated institution (JHU-DC Center, SAIS). A maximum of 6 political science courses can be transferred into Hopkins to fulfill the political science electives (PS classes needed on top of subfield courses to bring the total up to 13). The thesis seminar can count towards fulfilling the requirement as a political science elective.
